2012 "POT 'O GOLD" RAFFLE RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The ANNUAL NORTHEAST CLASSIC "POT 'O GOLD" RAFFLE is conducted by the Northeast Classic Car Museum, Inc., an educational corporation organized under the laws of the State of New York, chartered by the Education Department. All proceeds, less expenses and prizes, will benefit the Northeast Classic Car Museum.

2. The purchase price of a 2012 ANNUAL NORTHEAST CLASSIC "POT 'O GOLD" RAFFLE ticket is \$50.00 each. Checks or money orders should be made payable to the Northeast Classic Car Museum. Payment may be made by Visa, Master Card, Discover or American Express by contacting the Northeast Classic Car Museum, 24 Rexford Street, Norwich, NY 13815 (607-334-AUTO) for instructions. Payments are not tax-deductible contributions. If an entrant's check or credit card payment is dishonored by the bank or credit card company, the entry will be declared invalid unless full payment of the ticket and any associated fees is made in good funds prior to the drawing.

3. Requests for tickets by internet or mail accompanied by payment in full must be in the possession of the Northeast Classic Car Museum, 24 Rexford Street, Norwich NY 13815 by noon on Thursday, March 15, 2012.

4. Due to postal regulations, raffle ticket stubs cannot be returned by mail for purchases over the Internet, through the mail or by telephone. When an order is placed, we will complete the ticket by filling in the name and contact information, and we will drop the ticket into the raffle bin. At the drawing, winners will be contacted based on the name and information on the ticket. To pick up a prize, two forms of identification, one of which must be a photo ID, will be required to prove that this person is the person named on the winning ticket. Purchasers do not need their ticket stubs for any reason. Winner(s) need not be present to win.

5. Purchasers of 2012 ANNUAL NORTHEAST CLASSIC "POT 'O GOLD" RAFFLE tickets must be 18 years of age or older, and must qualify under New York law.

6. The raffle prizes shall be as follows: Grand Prize \$10,000; 2nd prize \$5,000; 3rd prize \$2,500; (2) 4th prizes of \$1,000; (4) 5th prizes of \$500; (5) 6th prizes of \$250; (7) 7th prizes of \$150; (12) 8th prizes of \$100.

7. ONLY 1,000 TICKETS WILL BE SOLD. Sales of raffle tickets will be closed at 1:30 PM on the day of the drawing, or when 1,000 tickets have been sold, whichever comes first.

8. If all 1,000 tickets are not sold by the date of close, prizes will be awarded on a pro-rated basis according to total monies collected.

9. The winners will be determined by random drawing. The drawing will take place on March 16, 2012 at 2:00pm at the Northeast Classic Car Museum. Preliminary announcement of the winners will be made as drawn. Confirmation of winner eligibility will be made and names of winners will be posted at the Northeast Classic Car Museum and on the Museum's website at www.classiccarmuseum.org.

10. Winners will assume and be responsible for payment of the required federal withholding tax, if any, at the time prizes are awarded, and all other fees, and local, state and federal taxes, including without limitation, all applicable sales, use, luxury, and income taxes.

11. More than one name may be stated on the raffle ticket. However, the first listed name shall be deemed the "entrant." Delivery of the prize shall be made solely to the entrant upon payment of the required federal withholding tax, if any, furnishing the entrant's Taxpayer Identification Number, if required, and documentary identification satisfactory to the Northeast Classic Car Museum. It is the sole responsibility of the entrant in a multiple-party entry to allocate any such prize among the participants in the multiple-party entry.

12. The decision of the Northeast Classic Car Museum shall be final on all matters concerning the ANNUAL NORTHEAST CLASSIC "POT 'O GOLD" RAFFLE.

13. The staff, volunteers, and trustees of the Northeast Classic Car Museum, at their discretion, may participate in the ANNUAL NORTHEAST CLASSIC "POT 'O GOLD" RAFFLE.

14. The winners agree to permit his/her name(s) and photographic likeness(es) to appear in any Northeast Classic Car Museum publicity.

15. If any winner of the drawing fails to claim the prize or satisfy all conditions listed above within 30 days of the date of the drawing, another winner will be drawn by the Museum's Executive Committee.
